

Hebrew word for "holy" - Qadosh Qadosh — "being separated; set apart; sacred"



How are we going to live with God dwelling among us without us sinners being struck dead because of His divine holiness?

Answer: LEVITICUS!

Leviticus 19:5-8 <sup>5</sup> "When you offer a sacrifice of peace offerings to the LORD, you shall offer it so that you may be accepted. <sup>6</sup> It shall be eaten the same day you offer it or on the day after, and anything left over until the third day shall be burned up with fire. 7 If it is eaten at all on the third day, it is tainted; it will not be accepted, <sup>8</sup> and everyone who eats it shall bear his iniquity, because he has profaned what is holy to the LORD, and that person shall be cut off from his people.
