


Glimpse of God's intended unity for the Church








#### 1 Corinthians 12:12-13






#### 1 Corinthians 12:15-16




















Different giftings encourage reliance on one another.


Overall, there should be a full reliance on Christ in all we do.

#### 1 Corinthians 12:31 - 13:3


