## POLICIES

### **Standard of Conduct**

Students will seek to “be imitators of God” with “not even a hint of sexual immorality, or any kind of impurity,” living as “children of light” and finding out “what pleases the Lord” (Ephesians 5:1-12). This standard governs our personal and public life.

### **Attendance**

Students are expected to attend classes regularly and punctually. **All sessions are held on-site, except for overseas students.** The maximum number of absences permitted is two (2) days; the maximum number of absences during the second semester is eight. Exceptions to this policy will be made only for extreme circumstances and emergencies. If a student's absences and tardiness total more than five (5) days, it is likely that the student will not receive a Certificate of Completion.

### **Discipline of Students**

The freedom of the **The Pentecost School** environment requires a high level of self-management. Any student struggling to make wise choices will receive quick and direct confrontation, which is designed to help draw out the greatness within the student. Our staff and pastoral teams are trained and empowered to apply strength and grace in whichever areas necessary of students' lives.

## **Withdrawal**

Any student who wishes to withdraw from the school must do the following:

- Arrange an appointment with the school coordinator to discuss the reasons for withdrawing from the school.
- A full refund will be given for withdrawal within the first week of school.

There will be no tuition refund thereafter.
